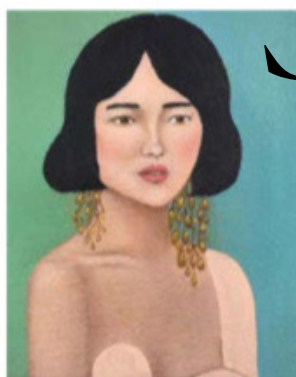

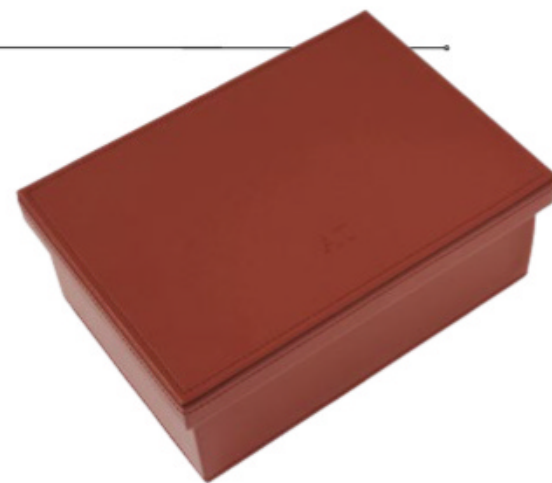

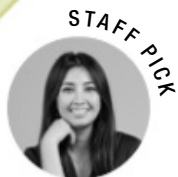

L'Officine Universelle Buly is an historic French apothecary that has recently experienced an international renaissance

AS YOU ENTER the flagship store of l'Officine Universelle Buly (aka Buly 1803) in Saint Germain, Paris, you leave behind the streets flocked with designer brands and step into, well, 1803. Which is where this story begins. The original "Buly" was Jean-Vincent Bully, a perfumer in the 19th century who had earned celebrity status for his unique fragrance formulations and scented vinegars. Fast-forward a few centuries to when the Bully name was acquired and the beauty brand reimagined as l'Officine Universelle Buly by Ramdane Touhami and his wife Victoire in 2014. Today, the vinegar has been replaced with a roll call of skincare, soaps, perfumes, combs, candles and toothpaste that are free from harmful fillers and chemicals. The fragrances use a water-based formulation instead of a traditional alcohol-based one, and the candles are made from plant-based ingredients. But back to the flagship store. It's not just the old-school apothecary fit-out that nods to its history – it's the marble basins and countertops, the worn, decorative tiles, the ornate brass faucets, and the floor-to-ceiling wood cabinetry filled with beautiful concoctions. Plant-based oils lining the countertop are sourced from indigenous plants all over the world, including sandalwood seed from Australia, and the impeccably suited sales staff know exactly which one is right for you. But the real pièce de résistance is the in-house calligrapher who personalises the packaging of each purchase – and that's enough to make anyone feel decidedly aristocratic. Jean-Vincent would be proud. 🍷

And always introduce at least one piece with angles to balance out all that volume.

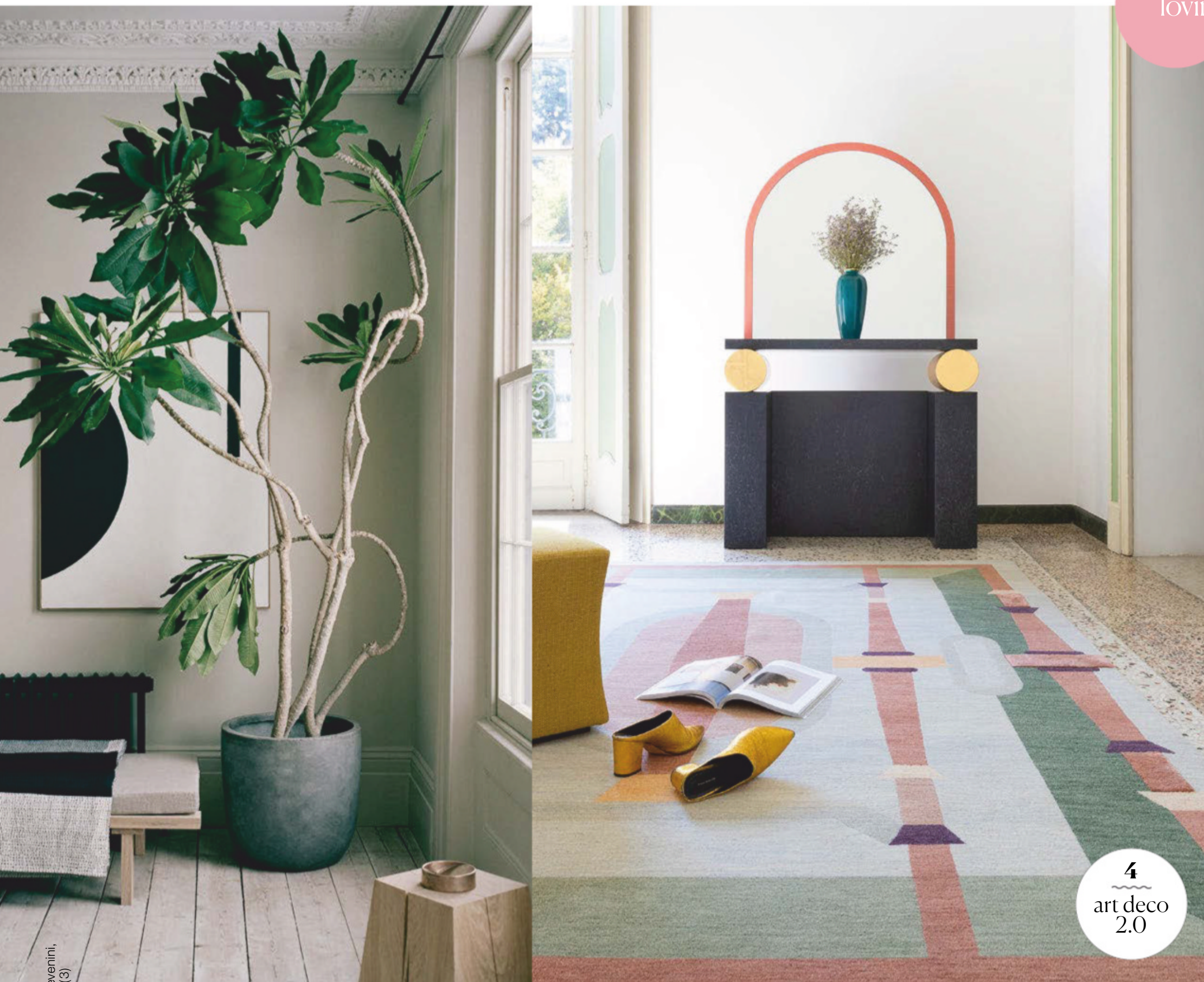

A refreshing renovation and sophisticated monochromatic colour scheme give this 19th century Paris apartment a modern feel

FRENCH STYLE IS FRAUGHT WITH SEDUCTIVE CLICHÉS. But a glimpse inside the home of Marie De Andreis, and you can't help but fall for them all over again. Marie, an Italian-born Parisian, designer and artistic director, moved here with her husband Raphael and three children when they outgrew their previous home. "We've always lived in this neighbourhood, but our old apartment was too small. We needed extra room and fell for this place," Marie says of the apartment. It's easy to see why. Everything from the wall mouldings to the marble fireplaces and herringbone parquet floors exudes elegance.

NEW WAVE Built around 1890, the apartment needed major work before Marie and her family could move in. They tore down a wall separating the original hallway and living room and turned this space into an open-plan kitchen, dining and living area, which Marie says is the heart of their home. "We often have friends and family around for dinner, which is so much more convenient in an open, connected space." With the dividing walls gone, natural light streams in from all sides.

BLANC SPACE The apartment's timeless white walls, stucco ceilings and double doors highlight the beauty of its dark oak floors, and while this contrast is a classic combination, Marie has put her own spin on it. "I make decisions based on how I feel rather than following certain rules," she says of her decorating style, which includes an eclectic mix of vintage treasures and modern art. Rooms are anchored with a few curated pieces of furniture in classic, feminine shapes. "I've chosen white because it creates a quiet environment," she explains. "At the same time, I wanted to mix in noble materials such as wood and marble, which continues from the bathroom to the kitchen benchtops and the Tulip dining table." 📌



Liberty, simplicity, femininity Two Noa sofas and a rug, all from Maison Sarah Lavoine, define the living space. 1

To achieve a classic black and white scheme, paint the walls and choose furniture in bright, brilliant shades of white without any yellow undertone.

Make one shade the dominant hue – in Marie's home it's white – and use the other as an accent. Think photo frames, trims, lights and soft accessories.

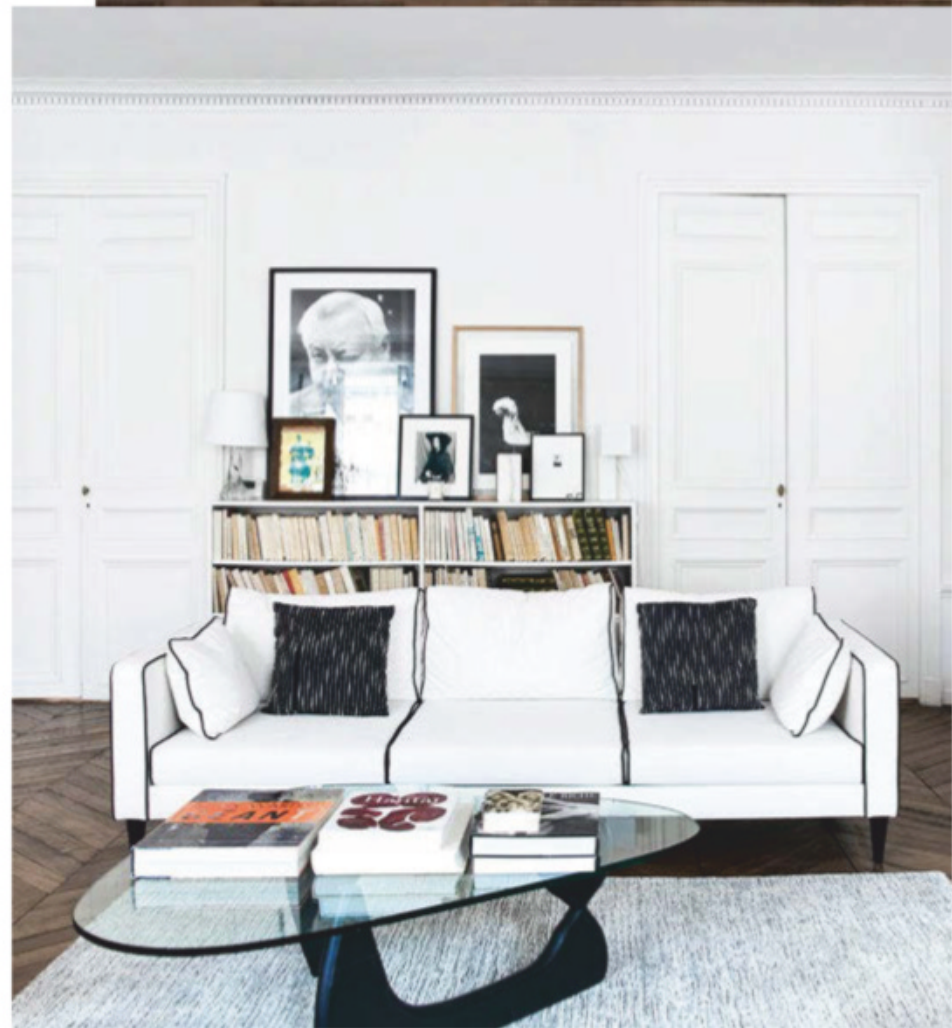
Mix in tonal shades to avoid a room that resembles a chessboard. Here, grey marble veins, wicker chairs and wooden frames temper the look.

FOUR YEARS AGO, BELGIAN ARTIST Laurence Leenaert arrived in Marrakech, Morocco, with just 400 euros and a sewing machine to her name. Fast-forward to 2019 and her distinctive LRNCE brand of homewares and textiles is coveted all over the world. The secret to her super-speedy success? Well, Laurence puts it down to hard work, the influence of Instagram and the constant inspiration that her adopted city provides. “My drawings have always been naive and childish,” she says. “Tribalism has forever interested me, along with the art that I’ve seen and studied. All of that fuses together here in Marrakech.”

NEW BEGINNINGS Enchanted with their new life in this frenetic and energetic metropolis, Laurence and her partner Ayoub chose to settle in a modest, two-bedroom home in the suburb of Gueliz. Inside, white plaster walls provide a simple blank canvas against which her colourful paintings, ceramics and textiles positively pop. A careful edit of chairs, rugs and fabrics, all hand-crafted by local artisans in her favoured palette of pink, mustard and blue, complete the picture. “I love to be surrounded by my stuff,” she says. “When I come back from a trip to see all my work, my books and my stuff, it makes me very happy.”

“In Marrakech, anything is possible. Living in the Medina,

COUPLE’S RETREAT Out the back, a large paved terrace surrounded by tall, rust-coloured walls is where Laurence and Ayoub choose to enjoy most of their meals. The space is divided into different zones – the outdoor dining table that Laurence painted in one, a plush daybed atop a sea of rugs in another – making it an ideal retreat where Laurence can sit and gather her thoughts each morning. She likes to start with a freshly brewed coffee... although she rarely drinks it. “I just like the ritual of making it, sitting outside and having 15 minutes for myself,” she says. “And then I leave for work, often going by the medina first, to see the artisans.” It all sounds pretty idyllic to us! 🍵

how to work with abstract prints

MOST PEOPLE DREAD COMING HOME after a holiday. Not Lill Jenner. For this stylist and mum-of-two, returning to her home on Sydney's North Shore is "calming and therapeutic, the best feeling in the world". That might seem like a bit of a stretch, until you find out her home was originally designed by Peter Hall, the architect famous for completing the Opera House. "You could tell it was a passion project between the owners and the architect. It felt very loved," Lill says of the property that she bought with her husband Lucas in 2017. "We're interested in architecture and beautiful spaces, and were drawn to its simplicity. But there was something else that felt magical about it," she recalls. "In a spiritual way it felt like we were meant to have this house."

AUSSIE ICON Spread across one level, Lill says her home was made for the Australian lifestyle. "It's a testament to Peter Hall that this house is still the perfect design decades later," she praises. "It's really sustainable; cool in summer and warm in winter. And it's designed to complement the natural environment, something more houses today should consider!" Glass sliding doors and floor-to-ceiling windows connect the living area and bedrooms to the backyard and courtyard, which her daughters Essie and Billie call the "Secret Garden". "Although the design looks simple, the devil is in the detail. It has such a great flow and feel."

RETRO RELAXO Lill's love of design from the '60s and '70s is a perfect match for her home, which was built in the 1970s. "Most of the furniture we had in our old home works beautifully here. It was as if we had been collecting pieces with this house in mind." A palette of dusty pink, peach, egg yolk yellow and "every tone of brown" complements the existing brick and timber interiors. "The colours I use reflect my personal styling," Lill says with a laugh. "I'm partial to a head-to-toe beige outfit!" 🏡



Original interiors Cork floors and pine ceilings exude textural warmth in the kitchen. working with timber ceilings

If you're lucky to have ceilings like Lill's, make a feature of them by painting the walls a warm white and choose pieces with natural finishes, like these rattan chairs. With so much texture overhead, opt for lightweight fabrics, such as linen curtains. →



Go with the flow To create continuity, the same materials feature in multiple rooms. For example, klinki pine plywood in the dining area was used in the bathroom vanity. A towel from The Beach People hangs on the wall, and the Kaiser porcelain vases are often filled with flowers from the garden. **The sisterhood** Essie and Billie share a bedroom – it's the largest room in the house. Their Muji beds are decorated with colourful Of The Sun linen and Ikea rugs. **Shady spot** "This house is the perfect entertainer, it's another reason we were drawn to it," Lill tells. The outdoor dining area features a white table from Spence & Lyda and vintage chairs. There's also a tennis court and plenty of shade for hosting barbecues.



'70s-inspired decorating tips

1

Embrace an earthy palette. Inspired by nature, shades of tawny brown, tan and terracotta will complement an existing neutral colour scheme.

Speaking of nature, add indoor plants in abundance. Rubber trees and fiddle leaf figs were (and still are) all the rage, or hang Devil's Ivy and ferns from the ceiling.

3

Natural materials and finishes give a distinctly '70s vibe. Opt for bamboo, terrazzo, timber and rattan – they'll work with those earthy tones, too!

Take the texture up a notch. Start with a shaggy high pile rug, chunky knits, crocheted throws and cushions. Add some leather and a tassel or two. →

If you’re making big layout changes, consult a professional plumber or electrician rather than attempting these works yourself. →

Where to scrimp Consider flat-pack kitchens with cabinet doors you can paint yourself; check out wholesalers for handles and tapware. **Where to splurge** A sturdy benchtop that won't chip or crack is a must, as are good-quality appliances. Check energy ratings and water-efficiency, look for added features like "self-cleaning" functions, and ask about package deals!

HOW TO MAKE

Redecorating a room? Compile your samples and inspiration in a display that you can see and touch. Here are three styles to try

A MOODBOARD

try a pinboard for your bedroom

What you'll need A large corkboard that can be hung on the wall. Collect images that speak to you, including magazine clippings, pictures printed from Pinterest and photocopied pages from books. You'll also need physical samples, such as paint swatches, textural materials and curtain and bedding fabrics.

Where to start The beauty of this moodboard is that it's made for layering, so you can see which colours and fabrics work together. If your heart is set on a few paint shades, buy sample tins, paint each colour onto paper and move them around. Thread string through pieces of curtain fabric to see it "hung" in 3D, and if you like to decorate with fresh flowers, pin a few to the board to bring it all to life.

Why it works Your bedroom is the place you daydream about, which is why it makes sense to project your vision onto a beautiful wall display. This board is best for lightweight samples that you can secure with pins and tape – a perfect match for the fabrics, swatches and images you'll need to dream up a bedroom. →

A moodboard should feel harmonious, without being limited to

try a “mood tray” for your kitchen

What you'll need A spacious tray with raised edges. Then, samples of the flooring, cabinetry, benchtops, splashbacks, wood stains, paints and fixtures you like. You can order samples online from most retailers, and at some paint shops and DIY hardware stores like Bunnings, paint swatches are free.

Where to start Think of the tray as the base of your room and stack from the ground up. Start with flooring samples, then materials for the other surfaces. Once you have the foundation, mix and match handles, hooks and tapware in brass, copper, wood, leather or stainless steel to create a cohesive look.

Why it works You won't find any flimsy fabrics on a kitchen moodboard, but you will be gathering solid samples of timber, laminate, stone and tiles. A tray is basically a portable platform for arranging and carrying samples, so you can take it with you when selecting accessories or paint colours in store. And if you're renovating at another location, you can bring your mood tray with you. →

What you'll need An A3 scrapbook with thick pages, glue, pens, paper clips and envelopes. Gather images that suit your style, clippings from books, catalogues and magazines (not just interior design mags; find inspo in fashion and travel ones, too), and carpet, rug, upholstery and curtain swatches.

Where to start Spread the images out on a table and play around with what looks good together before pasting them in. You might start with a sofa you already own (or have your eye on), or a colour scheme you've decided on, and create a mood around that. You can keep loose swatches safe in an envelope glued to the page, and add to the book as you collect more fabric and ideas.

Why it works Decorating a living room involves choosing lots of fabrics, and a scrapbook is a great place to collate all those samples. Fabric will sit flat and fold-out, and you can label each one on the page to keep track of where it's from. You can also take your book to showrooms and haberdashery stores. 📖

knick-knacks

From a vintage market find to an art gallery piece, mementos picked up while on holiday are easy to work back into your home decor. Choose something small that will work within a vignette on your bedside, shelf or coffee table with other items such as plants and books. Small items are easier to pack, too! →

colour schemes

The colours of a foreign place often inspire our own decorating. Take pictures of everything that catches your eye, even close-up details. It could be the hues of a sunset, colours of the fruit and veg at a market or the subtle tones in the brick of some ancient ruins that influences your bedroom or kitchen makeover.

lighting

You can buy some spectacular – and sometimes more affordable – lighting overseas; designs that you may not find here. If you fall in love with a piece of furniture while travelling overseas, ask the retailer if they offer an international shipping service. Sometimes the larger stores do, so you don't have to organise your own (a total nightmare). Be aware, though, that there is usually a months-long wait for your buys to arrive.

artworks

Paintings, illustrations and prints are fairly easy to transport – wrap them flat or roll them up and secure in sturdy packaging. Take them as carry-on or pack in your suitcase if you dare. Don't bother with frames as you can get that done back home. If the item's oversized, best to ask about shipping (see *furniture*). →

Playing with multiple motifs can actually have a harmonious effect on your home. Here are some fun ways to spice up any space

Update your accessories Experimenting?

Start with throws, cushions and doona covers. When working with soft finishes, don't be afraid to clash large-scale prints. Update bold florals with broad stripes, or pair a maximalist tropical palm design with a black-and-white animal print.

Take it to the floor Layering rugs is one of the most simple (and practical) ways to mix pattern. You'll need two different rugs. If they both have bold designs, ensure the colour palette or the shape of their motifs is cohesive. And if one rug is neutral, go ahead and make the other vibrant.

Work with your walls Printed wallpaper adds personality to a room and doesn't require much extra styling. When decorating with two designs, choose one with a large shape or motif print and match it to a similar small-scale print. To ensure the room feels "put together", opt for furnishings that echo the dominant colours in the wallpaper.

Try it in small doses Styling a room with layers of pattern can be intimidating. The good news is you can blend prints in subtle ways, too. Display picture frames with different decorative borders, mix and match your bedsheets or line a bookshelf with the leftover printed wallpaper.

Embrace the tile trend Moroccan-inspired tiles are enjoying a revival, so if you're planning a kitchen or bathroom redesign, why not make patterned tiles the feature? Create a patchwork of tiles on your walls, floor or splashback, keeping the colour and size consistent.

Art counts, too Hang prints or paintings that have a colourful abstract design or repetitive motif. A bold piece of art can also help inform the types of patterns you add to the room, such as geometric shapes or tribal lines. Display the picture near a bright piece of furniture or on a painted feature wall for a stunning visual clash. 🎨

PAINT IT

furniture bespokeing

Make a budget buy look like a million bucks with a bespoke paint job (that can be done over a weekend)

You'll need: drop sheet; 40-60 and 360-600 grit sandpaper; old clean cloth; primer; cutting-in paint brush; short nap roller; paint tray; angled brush; paint

1 Lay down drop sheet and strip the original paint with 40-60 grit sandpaper. Folding the sandpaper in thirds instead of halves will help you get a better grip and more surface control.

2 Wipe the furniture so it's free of debris and dust, making sure you get into all the corners.

3 Apply primer from the top down with your cutting-in brush or roller. Primers have different drying times depending on their base (oil or water), so check the instructions on the tin.

4 Wash cutting-in brush thoroughly, then once primer is dry, apply the paint colour of your choice getting into all the edges and joints.

5 Paint the rest of your furniture piece using the roller or angled brush, depending on the type of surface you're painting. Use short, horizontal strokes starting at the top and working your way down. Ensure the surface looks smooth, but avoid going over one section too often.

6 Allow to dry completely, then give the entire surface a very light sand with 360-600 grit sandpaper to remove paint dribbles and visible strokes until smooth and even.

7 Repeat steps 4 and 5 with a second coat of paint, again being careful not to fuss over finished areas as this can create lines. Let dry.

Tips: Satin-finish paint is a great option for side tables, chairs and shelving because it gives the item a moisturised, lustrous look without too much sheen. Semigloss paint has a more eye-catching finish – perfect for kid's rooms. 📌

WHEN IT COMES TO CREATING YOUR FOREVER HOME, interior designer Sonja Kritzler believes simplicity and durability is key. “My material choices tend to be restrained and I keep my selections to a minimum, repeating them throughout the home for a cohesive look.” Case in point: this new-build project in a leafy suburb of Sydney that she completed for her clients Zac and Marcia Kuzmanoski and their two young children, Zachary and Zara. 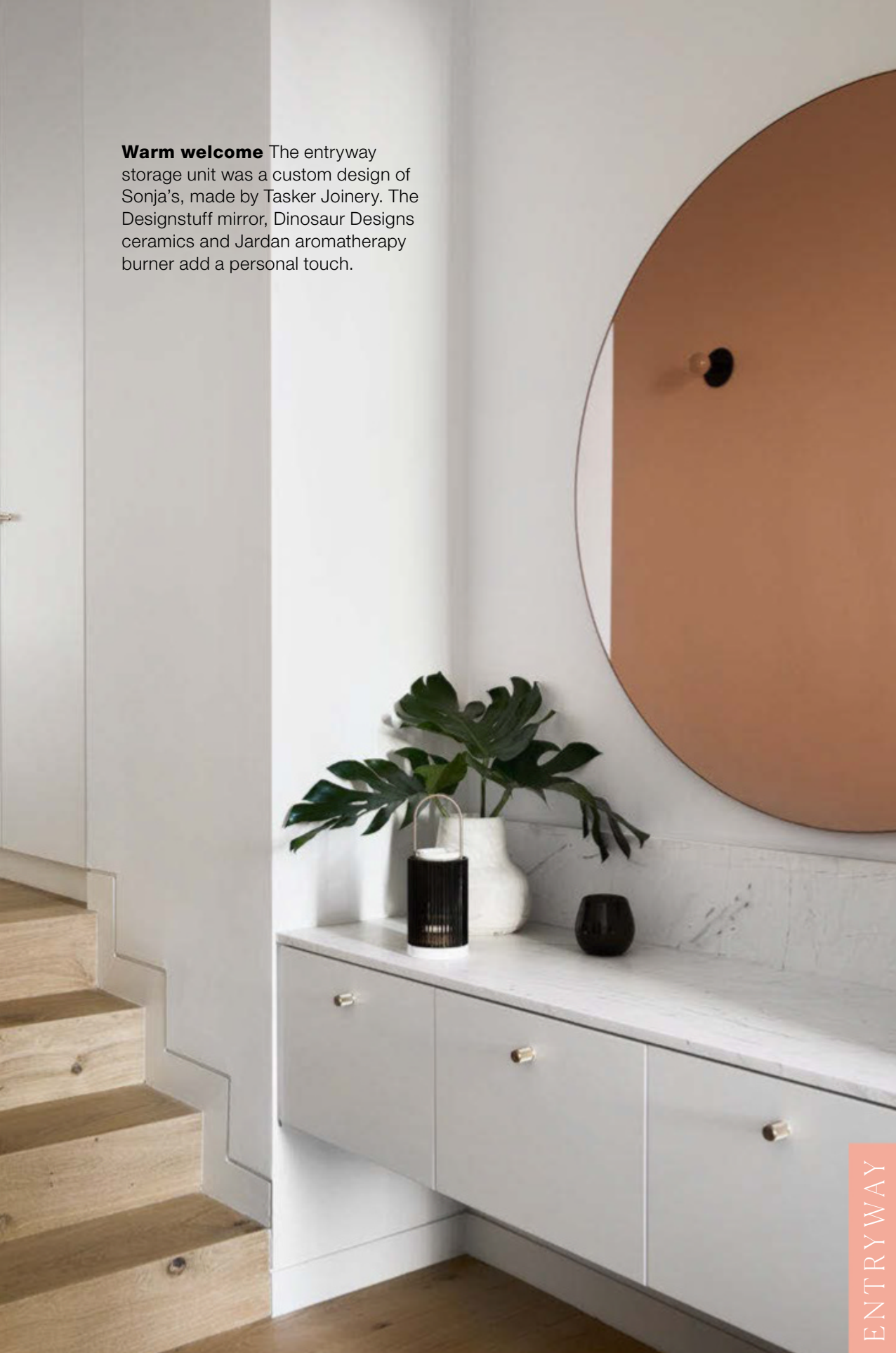

If you have the budget to work with an interior designer, the perks are many. Top of the list is the fact that they can create a home design and layout that is unique to you. 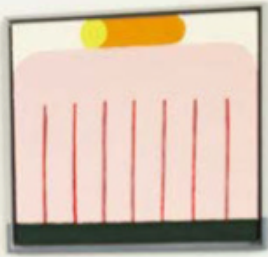

HOW TO EARN & SAVE

money moves to make

Planning a trip overseas? *Money* mag's Effie Zahos has tips for paying off your holiday, organising your finances and saving in the process

1

LAYBY YOUR HOLIDAY

Yes, the concept of layby applies to vacations, too. **TravelPay offers a true layby option in that you have to pay off your holiday before you leave.** TravelPay passes the full amount of your travel costs onto your booking agent upfront, so the price and exchange rates are locked in. Repayment options of up to 10 months are available, and an establishment fee of \$100 (\$200 for 10 months) applies, plus a 2.5% transfer fee on each instalment. Your last payment needs to occur at least 14 days prior to your departure date. However, not all travel agents offer TravelPay. **Another option is LayAway Travel.** This is a total holiday layby service, where packages include return flights between your departure city and destination, accommodation and airport transfers. **No deposit is required,** however the first instalment must be made within seven days of booking.

2

GET A TRAVEL CARD

Travel cards work much like a debit card at EFTPOS and ATMs. Your card is loaded with a set amount of foreign currency, and the card balance can be checked online. If funds run low, top it up via internet banking, and at the end of your trip, any remaining funds can be transferred to your bank account. Look for cards with very low or no reloading, withdrawal or transaction fees. Four cards that got a 5-star rating from Canstar research house were ANZ, HSBC, QANTAS and Travelex.

BUY NOW, PAY LATER

If you book through **Flight Centre**, it offers **an interest-free credit card that goes towards purchasing a holiday and flights** that are over \$999. Terms of up to 12 months can apply, although nine months is more common. Because it's essentially a credit card, you'll need to fill in an application form and have a credit check completed. An application fee of \$99 applies. While it's a great way to lock in your holiday and avoid price hikes, **be sure to pay it off during the interest-free period** – after that the interest rate becomes 25.99%. **AfterPay is another buy now, pay later service** that allows you to lock in the price of domestic and international flights. A 1.5% non-refundable payment fee applies at the time of booking, but there are no interest charges, just **four equal fortnightly instalments**, with the first made when you book. Travel arrangements cannot exceed \$1200, and be mindful that late fees apply.

EXCHANGE MONEY WISELY

If you think coffee is expensive at the airport, take a look at the buy and sell rates when you exchange money. Converting currency is almost 10 per cent more expensive at the airport than any other option*. I put this to the test with \$250 that I wanted to convert to US dollars. At the airport, I was charged a \$4.90 fee and walked away with just \$US155. At a bank I got back \$US168 but was charged a \$10 fee. A currency exchange store in the city proved to be the best value – I left with \$US175. There's no shame in negotiating a better rate, and the more currency exchanges around, the easier it is to haggle. And remember, converting larger sums will get you a better return.

5

FIND A CHEAP FLIGHT

There are many **flight comparison websites** you can use to search airfares, such as **Skyscanner, Expedia or Webjet**. Or if you don't mind a 10-hour (or more) stopover, check out **CleverLayover**. Instead of scouring the internet for all the connecting flights yourself, this online tool can give you **the cheapest round trip at the click of a button**. The only downsides are your flight may include more than one stop, and their deals are currently only available in American dollars. ❶

“I’M GOING TO THE FLOWER MARKET – do you need me to get you anything?” This question was the beginning of MyFlowerMan, the Sydney florist run by Kieran Birchall and Georgia Martin. Kieran, who worked in real estate at the time, initially went to the flower market on a whim, but loved the experience and so went back week after week, creating arrangements for friends and family and posting pics on Instagram. “I had been calling him ‘my flower man’,” Georgia says, “and it just stuck”.

That was nearly five years ago, and the business has since evolved into a full-time affair. “Moving a hobby into a fully functioning business gives you amazing insights into what your clients want. But it was also important to stay true to our personal aesthetics and ethos,” Georgia says. The couple prefer a pared-back palette and conveniently, their customers do too, typically requesting whites and greens. Another hallmark of their designs is texture. “Because we use muted colours or variations of white, texture becomes even more important,” Georgia says. “We love combining flowers like flannel, David Austin roses, anemone and ranunculus with arrow leaves or various foliage,” she adds. If you’re lucky enough to have a garden at home, Georgia recommends growing hydrangeas, roses, tulips, Canterbury bells, hellebores or ranunculus, which all look stunning en masse in a vase. →



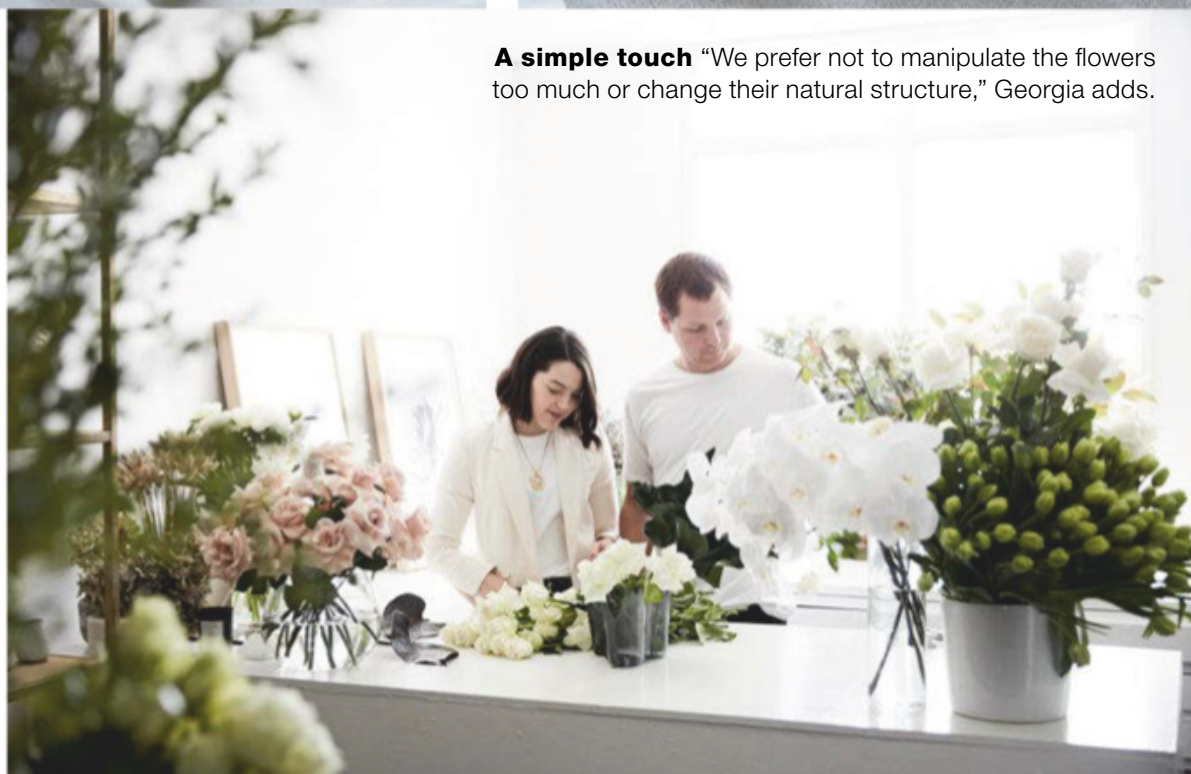


Keep it green Use foliage from the garden to fill out your arrangements. "Deep green arrow leaves are a favourite of ours," Georgia says.



In shape "If you're wanting to start arranging your flowers yourself, a bell or dome style vase – anything smaller at the top and wider at the bottom – is easy to work with," Georgia says.

A simple touch "We prefer not to manipulate the flowers too much or change their natural structure," Georgia adds.



Signature style Working within a tight palette – like MyFlowerMan's signature whites and greens – creates visual impact.

flower facts: true or false?

Cutting the stem on an angle helps the flower drink more water.

Yes we do this and feel it works better compared to a straight cut.

Smashing the woody stems of flowers makes them drink more water.

Not saying it doesn't work, but we find the simple snip and fresh water is sufficient.

Bleach in the water will keep it clean and the flowers will last longer.

We put a cap of bleach into our weekly installations as they often don't get trimmed or have the water changed. It helps keep bacteria at bay so the flowers last longer.

To revive hydrangeas, submerge the heads in water for 30 minutes.

Yes you can do this, but make sure the stems are cut and submerged too.

Spray hairspray on the blooms to keep them looking fresh for longer.

No not for us, it feels very unnecessary.

Change the water and cut the stems every day to make flowers last longer.

YES!! Please do this.

Stripping the leaves and thorns from roses is good for them. We do this, but more because leaves create bacteria in the water, which shortens the flowers' life span. They're also easier to handle sans thorns. 🍀

You choose "Vases are very much a personal preference, as are the flowers you put in them," Georgia says. "We like to clump flowers in small ceramics."

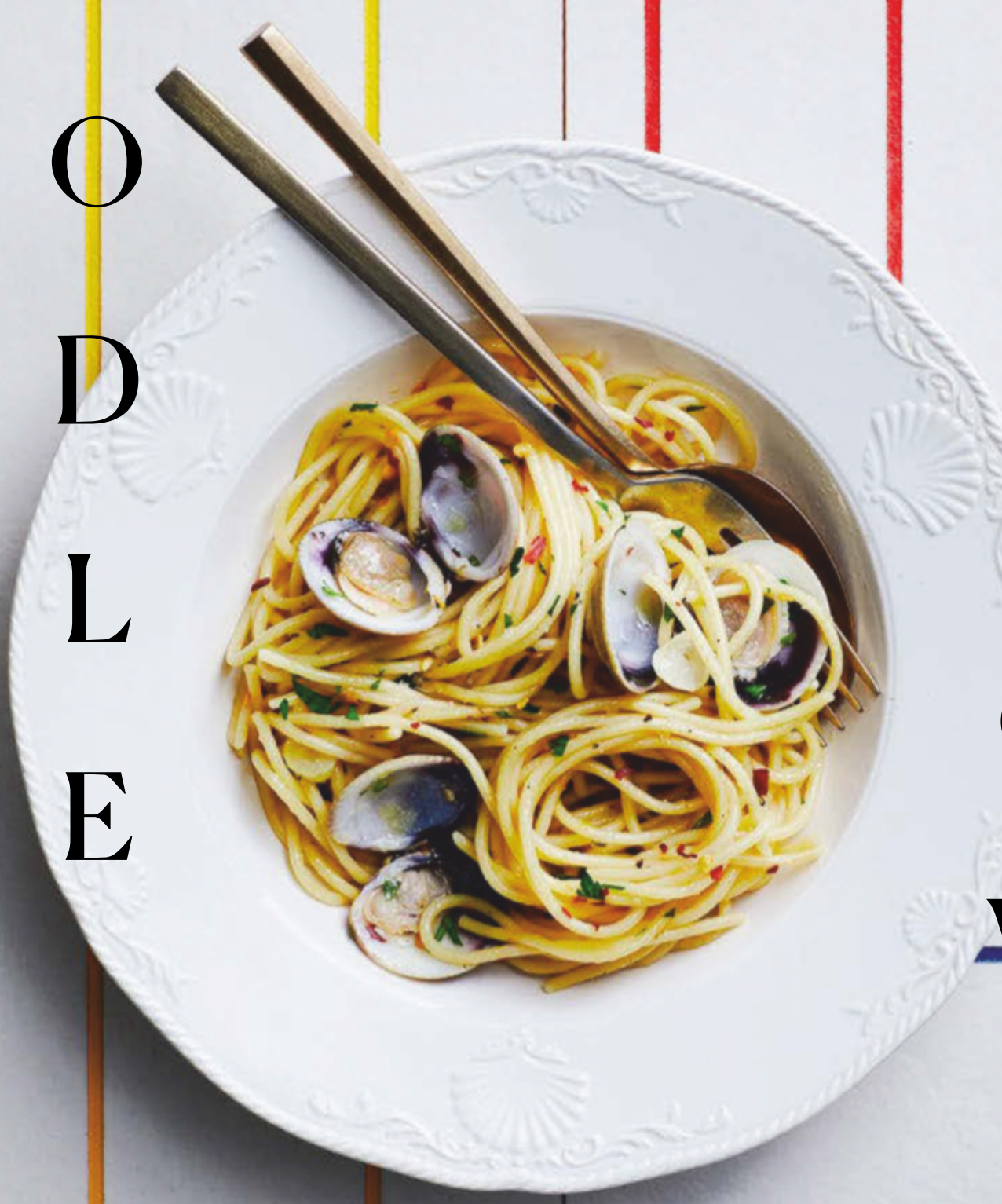

500g spaghetti

¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil

4 cloves garlic, finely sliced

1 tsp dried chilli flakes

⅓ cup dry white wine

300g small clams

½ bunch flat-leaf parsley,

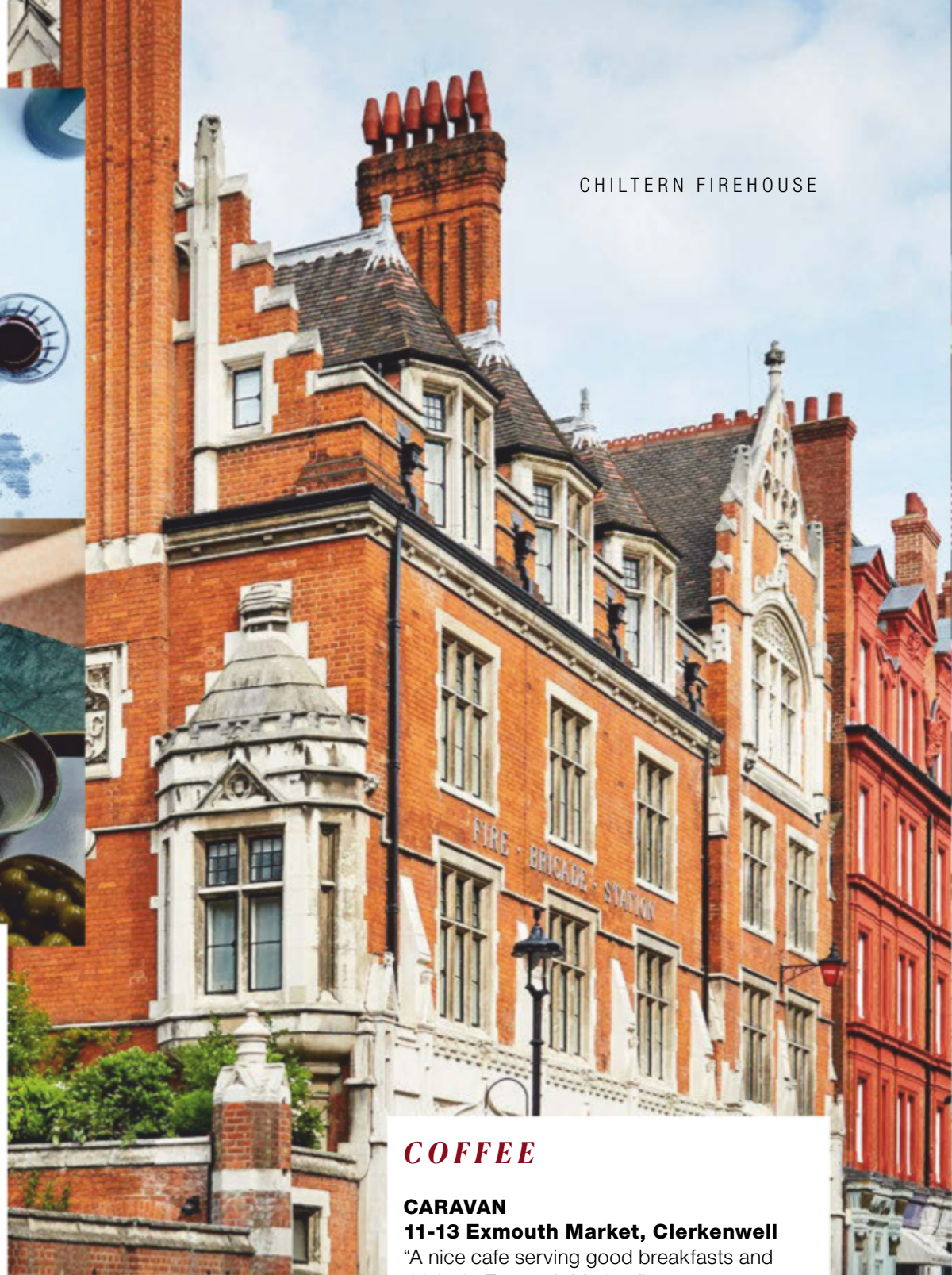

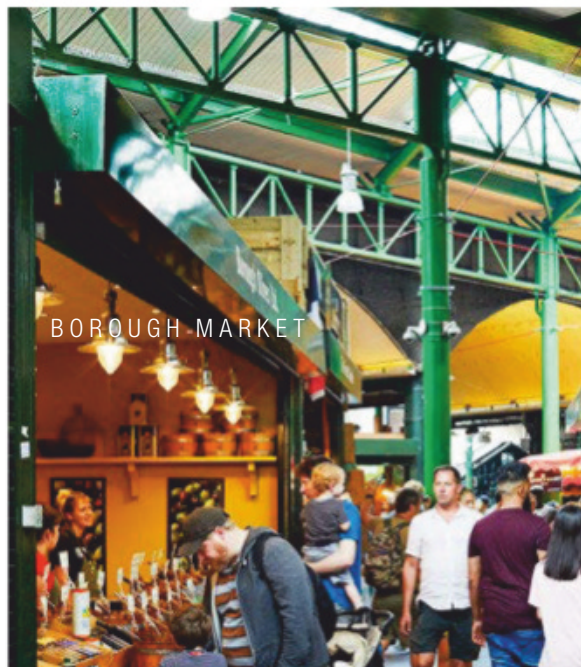

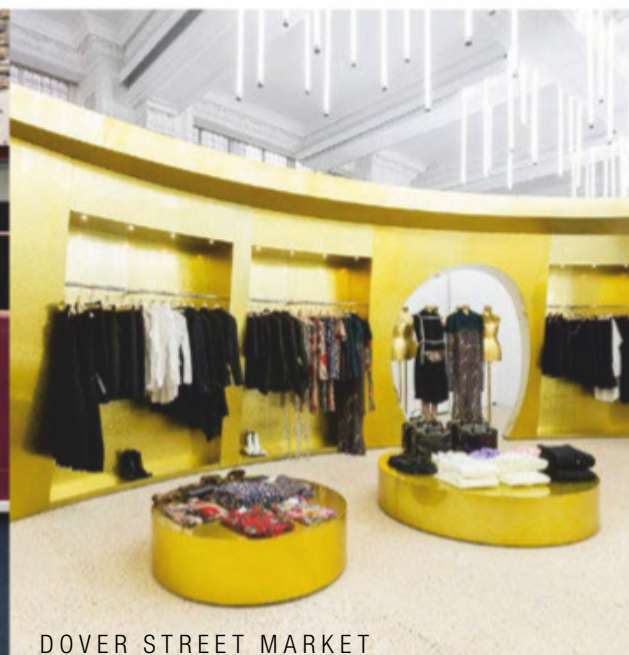

bristol calling

Frequently ranked as one of the best places to live in the UK, Bristol is loud, proud and packed with cool places to eat, sleep and explore



You can tell a lot about a town by its residents' taste in paint. For instance, the iconic terraces of Bristol are splashed in bold shades of blue, yellow and pink. Loud, colourful and unapologetic – it's the perfect summation of this spunky little city.

A TALE OF TWO CITIES

Towering above the city centre is Clifton Hill, the flash end of town, where a two-bedroom maisonette can command as much as a London apartment. Here, the Avon Gorge hotel has been thoughtfully restored, transforming the adjoining pub from a scary sports bar into a place you want to settle in for the afternoon. Meanwhile, less than half an hour's stroll away, you'll find Stokes Croft, where street art and rebellion reigns supreme. Take a 90-minute tour with locals Where The Wall for a history lesson on graffiti culture.

LOCAL HERO

While the UK's south west is often associated with the Georgian splendour of Bath, 20km to the west, Bristol is home to famed street artist Banksy. Of

course there's no shortage of old English charm – try King Street for gorgeous higgledy-piggledy pubs dating back to the 17th century.

SPACE TO CREATE

Spike Island, a gallery and shared studio, is a prime example of Bristolian cool. "We work really hard to keep it affordable for young artists to have a space here," says communications manager Jane

Faram. A 15-minute walk away is Ashton Court Estate, a historic park replete with deer!

A TASTE FOR INDEPENDENCE

The diversity continues at Wapping Wharf, where a swathe of cool restaurants and bars offer up everything from craft beer to Caribbean food. "There's an open-mindedness here that's really cool," says Rob Howell, head chef at restaurant Root, which serves a mostly plant-based menu. "We're not a vegetarian restaurant," he says, gesturing to the pork belly special, "there's just a lot of veg." The menu is surprising, unaffected and defies convention... not unlike Bristol itself. ❶





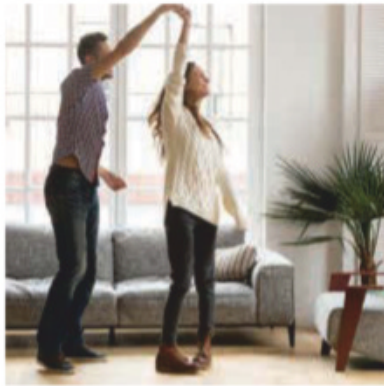
