



With its glossy, coral curves soaring 101 stories high, Jeanne Gang's latest effort, the St. Regis Chicago, (stregischicago.com) has leveled up the city's already-iconic skyline. When it came to creating interior spaces that would match the exterior's wow factor, one Chicago firm stood above the rest: KTGY Simeone Deary Design Group, the masterminds behind luxury projects like Chicago's Michelin-starred

Boka, a pair of ultraluxe cocktail bars at The Palazzo at The Venetian Resort in Las Vegas, and more. "Marriott's luxury St. Regis brand demands all the comfort and sophistication the exterior architecture implies," says KTGY associate principal Sara Talleux, who spearheaded the project along with senior interior design managers Susan Jacobs and Justin Brown.

Noting the spaces' elegant,



neutral aesthetic accented by glamorous design moments throughout, Talleux adds, "The interior design conjures monumentality and history, as well as modern art and jazz, all grounded in the city's singular story." Focusing on the property's public-facing spaces, presidential suite and spa, KTGY worked with materials and color palettes that juxtapose light and dark, and hard and soft to evoke a balanced sense of drama and elegance. "The hotel's double-height lobby immediately impresses with smoky marble floors and walls.

Above the high-gloss marble front desk, a floating chandelier, made of linear metal rods and glass orbs, invokes light peeking through the dust," Talleux says.

In the serene Iridium Spa, artworks sourced from NINE dots ARTS, an inviting lounge sofa from Ghidini 1961 and delicate lighting fixtures from RH, Visual Comfort and other top-notch vendors create an inviting essence reflective of the St. Regis' DNA. Adds Talleux, "Decked in pink pastel tones, rounded forms and fabric layers that mirror the lake shore, the sumptuous spa speaks to comfort and refinement as it reflects nature."

Retreat to the lofty presidential suite, and you'll find KTGY's signature from wall to wall. "The glamorous suite carries the characteristic juxtaposition in its rough carved



forms and sumptuous materials," says Talleux. "Bespoke abstract sculptures cohabit with industrial materials as neutral tones and organic shapes contrast with metallic details—all residing in impeccable luxury among 3,200 square feet of private space."







SCAD invites our more 'intrapreneurial' alumni—i.e., Bees applying their leadership and creative talents at an established brand—to bring their teams to SCADpro, our in-house business innovation lab that creates real products and services for Fortune 100 clients. Some of our biggest SCADpro assignments are the result of alumni who pitch the idea to their employers and who then help lead the assignment. One is Amanda Johns, hired as a UX designer by Gulfstream after a SCADpro assignment. Amanda's now back at SCADpro as a client, earning serious cred with her Gulfstream team while further advancing the brand.

As SCAD grads rise into leadership roles, they find themselves speaking and presenting more often—one reason I created SCADamp, where communication coaches work with alumni to hone their pitches and build confidence for the next chapter in their careers. Nearly 75% of Gen Z admit they struggle with workplace communication, and every recruiter who comes to SCAD says communication is the most important interpersonal skill they seek in new hires. NBC News recently reported on SCADamp as an innovative resource that advances our students' and graduates' careers.

SCAD hires alumni to return to campus and give talks on their careers, lead demos, review portfolios and more. The university also hires alumni to lead research initiatives for SCAD SERVE, which addresses urgent community needs in our hometowns. 

breezy, beautiful... Upward! Sherwin-Williams (sherwin-williams.com) released its annual Color of the Year 2024, and the color is providing respite for all our spaces. After plentiful research and design methodology, the Sherwin-Williams team pulls one throughline of color through their Color Forecast palettes, and this year, it's the calming, light blue dubbed Upward (SW 6239). "Easy, breezy, light and carefree," says director of color marketing Sue Wadden. "[Upward] is all about a calming expression of color. We are in a frantic time. We really wanted an opportunity for a color that is not a neutral but still very calming and simplistic. Upward pairs great with other colors, and it was really important to me to pick a color that counterbalances the weight of the world." Upward is just that.

In Sherwin-Williams' biennial trend report, Colormix Forecast 2024, Anthology: Volume One, the company explains that Upward offers a gentle push in the right direction, uplifting our moods and spaces but careful not to overwhelm them. "We've been tracking the importance of green over several seasons, and

what has emerged is that blue is going to overtake green and rise in importance," says Wadden. "Blue will represent what we will see in the next seasons. I wanted Upward to indicate what is to come because that is what Color of the Year should be."

Not only is the color a breath of fresh air, but its applications are versatile, perfect for respite spaces like bathrooms, bedrooms and closets and more unexpected spaces like the kitchen. Says Wadden, "Blue's not always a color for kitchens. It is a weird food color, so it doesn't always

translate to kitchens, but Upward is very airy and bright and translates a versatile feel. It can be beachy. It can feel modern." The perfect complement to a coastal chic kitchen, a grand millennial living room, or even a midcentury modern sitting room. Upward can revive an old vanity piece, complement the ceiling of your front porch, ward off evil spirits (according to the Gullah Geechee people), and even uplift your everyday mood. Fall in love with this color's overall calming effect and allow it to inspire your next home project.





THE CLIENT

From 1986 to 2020, Jeannine Dal Pra was known as an expert curator of cutting-edge home accessories, furniture, tabletop and jewelry at her must-shop concept store Elements. No surprise then, that when the store closed there was no shortage of clients reaching out to Dal Pra for design advice. Case in point: One regular asked if Dal Pra would visit their new apartment—a 3,200-square-foot gem with 10-foot ceilings and floor-to-ceiling windows with an expansive terrace off the living room and dining room areas—to provide input on the renovation and design. "The living room and dining areas are open to the kitchen," notes Dal Pra, "a perfect setup for entertaining for family gatherings and the

holidays." Intrigued, she offered her advice—and the client hired her to design the entire home.

THE PRIORITY

Speed was key for the client, who insisted that the project be ready for move-in within six months. For Dal Pra, now the founder and principal designer of her eponymous design firm, the aim was equally clear: "The client is stylish and chic, so the apartment needed to be sophisticated in order to blend with the client's personality."

THE CHALLENGE

In this age of delays and back orders, finishing the construction and custom designs within the client's six-month ask proved to be Dal Pra's

most significant hurdle. "Most of the custom design features were finished within six months, including the fireplace mantel and powder room vanity. However, not all the furnishings and the draperies were ready, but the client was able to be flexible for the special pieces that had longer lead times."

THE DETAILS

For Dal Pra, one of the smallest spaces—the foyer—proved to be the most special. "With so much light in the living room and dining room areas with the floor-to-ceiling windows, I felt that the foyer needed to be dark to create an inviting, warm and intimate feeling when entering the apartment. We installed Phillip Jeffries horsehair and metallic leaf paper with a Christian Astuguevieille black rope mirror and black wool and silk custom rugs from The Rug Company. As the black lacquer door of the apartment opens,

you become encompassed in this gorgeous, mysterious space." The library is another highlight for the designer. "Everything about the library is so inviting that you want to collapse into the deep sofa upholstered in Métaphores chenille fabric with a fascinating novel or watch a great movie. The walls are covered in a Carlisle & Co. handembroidered fringe on natural sisal, which creates texture and dimension to complete the warm and inviting feel of the room."

THE OUTCOME

In response to the finished product, the client was "overwhelmed with delight," says Dal Pra. "I provided exactly what was expected of me—a beautiful, comfortable home that was chic and sophisticated. My goal for my client? 

acquired an entire floor at No. 9 Walton, complete with a stunning terrace." Though the client interviewed other top Chicago design firms, the client's bond with Horner over their shared design principles and philosophies won out, and the project's team was set.

THE PRIORITY

Explains Horner, "The client aspired to create a space where he could host gatherings and truly feel at ease in his new residence; he also expressed his desire for a modern apartment, despite his prior experience with more traditional, historical homes. ideas and visual concepts, delving into how the apartment should evoke a particular ambiance. It became clear to him that we possessed the capacity to craft a design that aligned with his true desires, rather than what he initially thought he wanted."

THE CHALLENGE

"We were in the midst of the design and construction process when the COVID-19 pandemic struck. At that point, everything began to decelerate, and we encountered disruptions in the supply chain. We became increasingly worried about the ability of businesses to maintain their production and sustainability during these challenging times."


"This was truly a dream project," says Horner. "Our connection with the

client was truly exceptional, granting us the freedom to explore innovative design concepts. Among all the elements, my personal favorite has to be the kitchen. Sums up Horner, "As we walked through the space together, a continuous smile adorned our client's face. 
Where to Stay: Chalet Pelerin and Chalet Hibou—both by

historical waypoints dedicated to famous locals and movie stars. Where to Stay: HRH's lodging of choice, Hotel Arlberg Lech (arlberghotel.at) was founded in 1956 by Johann and Helga Schneider. Today, the family's third generation operates this luxe hotel. Some recently renovated rooms feature lime plaster walls and bespoke wall pigments inspired by nature and accented with rustic wood and natural stone. The family's dachshund, Pauli, patrols the halls.



Sedona is a magical place in its own right, but with the recent addition of Ambiente, a Landscape Hotel (ambientesedona.com), the Arizona destination has become even more extraordinary. Spiritual awakenings, wellness-minded journeys, and mind and body healing are nearly synonymous with Sedona, and as one of only 20 certified Dark Sky Communities in the world, the small town two hours north of Phoenix is a prime spot to stargaze and think big. Since its February 2023 debut, Ambiente Sedona, with its pristine views of the Coconino National Forest and red rock formations, is well positioned to inspire meditative moments of self-reflection and renewal.

On a recent visit to Ambiente, I discover the remarkable view is no coincidence. Jennifer May, co-owner of Two Sister Bosses—the Sedona company that owns, manages and developed the hotel—shares that after she helped build Mariposa, a Latin-inspired restaurant next door, the view was the main draw from the beginning. "The location for Ambiente





was chosen because it provides guests with the same stunning views, but from the privacy of an intimate, 3-acre resort," she says. "The location also provides convenient access to all of Sedona's main attractions and allows guests to enjoy the night sky beaming with stars, followed by waking up to the panoramic vistas illuminated by the Sedona sunrise—a moment we know guests will cherish," she says, referring to the views from each of Ambiente's 40 guest atriums and their rooftop patios. Each cubeshaped, glass-encased atrium was intentionally placed and rotated at specific angles to blend in with and seemingly float above the existing landscape, trees and flora. While walking around the property, it feels as though each atrium has been there forever, tucked into this sanctuary surrounded by natural waterways and unbelievable beauty. While the awe-inspiring

The atriums and common areas are decked out in wall art and sculptures from local Exposures International Gallery of Fine Art and Renee Taylor Gallery, and the Forty1 menu features a bounty of Bluebird Farms produce, Copper State Ranchers Reserve beef, Huss Brewing Co. and Smelter Town Brewery beers on tap, and more, making for both artful and flavorful ties to the Arizona community.





sights and sounds are the main attraction, the adults-only luxury property's amenities and activities are equally noteworthy. Ambiente boasts signature restaurant Forty1, a pond-shaped pool, and the intimate and luxurious Velvet Spa. One of my favorite aspects of the property is its close ties to local art galleries and food and beverage purveyors. "At the very beginning, sourcing and partnerships with other Arizona locals were of enormous importance

In lieu of an on-site fitness center, Ambiente encourages guests to take it outside and explore more than 200 miles of trails through mountain bike rentals and hiking tours, coordinated by its dedicated concierge team. The hotel also offers exclusive access to the Adobe Jack Trail system, where I had a surprise encounter with a pair of wild javelinas, pig-like animals native to the area, during an afternoon hike. For aspiring stargazers, Ambiente can coordinate a private experience with a professional astronomer who comes directly to the guest's atrium with powerful telescopes. For oenophiles, the hotel's partnership with local wine bar and tasting room The Art of Wine offers a sommelier-led wine tasting with local and global wines. For chill-seekers, Velvet Spa provides an in-depth menu of experiences, from intention-setting yogic transformations and healing sound journeys to meditation and an outdoor sauna. There's even one particularly indulgent option to experience a massage on your atrium's private rooftop under the stars. "We uniquely curated the cutting-edge wellness offerings at Velvet with my background of over 20 years of experience as a professional esthetician," May says. "The lavish treatments, along with the overarching composition of the spa, evoke a sense of grounding and reconnecting with the natural environment, bringing pristine tranquility to guests." As for me, a 90-minute ancient salt stone massage was a perfect and simply rejuvenating way to conclude my visit, and after an extended weekend at Ambiente, peaceful moments led to quiet introspection and a renewed sense of calm.

committed to sustainable travel, which has earned it the honor of being the only Norwegian travel company to be both Travelife and B Corp certified. So, let's begin our adventure, shall we?

GETTING THERE

Launched in spring 2021, Norse Atlantic Airways (flynorse.com) is the newest airline to offer direct flights from New York City, Fort Lauderdale and Los Angeles to Oslo. Opt for the airline's Plus class to enjoy spacious reclined seating, two in-flight meals, maximum baggage allowance, VIP check-in and increased ticket flexibility. Relax aboard Norse's fleet of Boeing 787 Dreamliners as you cruise for roughly seven hours from New York and 10 hours from Los Angeles. Once you land in Oslo, easily accessible trains can take you into the city or away from it, depending on your destination.

NATURAL WONDERS

Our journey with Up Norway begins in the idyllic village of Skåbu, Northern Europe's highest inhabited settlement, where roughly 600 Norwegians live year-round. Two of those residents are husband and wife Henrik and Jannicke, who opened Skåbu Fjellhotell (skabufjellhotell.no) in 2018. Warm and inviting, the 17-room lodge enchants with a crackling fireplace in the living room-style lobby and upscale dining at the on-site Restaurant Skadir. Led by chef Lukasz B. Socha, the concept is an adventure

in gastronomy with menus that change daily and highlight the bounty of the nearby fishing lakes and land—think pork, sheep, moose and bison. With snow on the ground during our visit in late March, our days in Norway's oldest village are spent dog-sledding with locals from Skåbu Mountain Adventure, snowshoeing and eating moose burgers at Henrik and Jannicke's family farm.

After departing from Skåbu, we travel by train along the famous Rauma Railway—as seen in Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince—to reach our next stop: Storfjord Hotel (storfjordhotel. com). Nestled within the trees in Glomset, with views of the Storfjord and the Sunnmøre Alps as its backdrop, this quietly luxurious hotel features 30 rooms and suites outfitted with fireplaces, heated floors, rustic furnishings and sumptuous linens. Take a dip beneath the trees in the outdoor hot tub as you sip Storfjord Brygg,

a Nordic beer brewed exclusively for the property. At dinner, head chef Ingeborg offers an everchanging four-course menu in the on-site restaurant. As always, Up Norway adds a special touch to our stay by coordinating a fireside cocktail hour inside a yurt, a morning kayak adventure and an authentic Norwegian lunch with local Inger Anne Tolaas at her family's farm.

THE ROYAL TREATMENT

One of the country's most breathtaking sights lies between Norway's majestic mountains fjords. These deep, narrow bodies of water reflect the snowcapped peaks above with a glasslike quality that inspires awe. To get



to our next destination, we board a private boat, sip Champagne and stop by Christian Gaard Bygdetun (christian-gaard.no), a pub in Trandal accessible only by the fjords. From there, we head to the historic Hotel Union Øye (unionoye.no), a Relais & Châteaux property frequented by royals since its opening in 1891. Every room is named for a famous guest-think King Haakon VII and Queen Maud of Norway—and all modern technology has been omitted to transport guests back in time. Sip a cocktail in the Palm Room as you enjoy views of Mount Slogen before heading to dinner in the exquisite Conservatory. By night, stars glimmer through the glass ceiling and a four-course prix fixe menu is paired with premium varietals from the multiroom wine cellar.

ALL ABOUT OSLO

A car, boat and plane ride later—a one-hour flight via Widerøe airlines—and we're back in Oslo. We check in to Sommerro House (sommerrohouse.com), a five-star property that once housed Oslo's electric company. Opened in 2022, the GrecoDecodesigned hotel offers Oslo's only year-round rooftop pool and draws gourmands to its popular restaurant Ekspedisjonshallen with a wraparound bar and live music.



Once rested, our final two days are full of history—the Royal Palace, where Their Majesties King Harald and Queen Sonja live, is just up the street from Sommerro, and our walking tour takes us to Akershus Fortress, a medieval site where many dramatic acts of war took place. (Its castle is the inspiration for Anna and Elsa's home in Disney's Frozen.) Finally, we toast a vacation well spent over reindeer sausages and ciders, and celebrate like the locals by indulging in a sauna session at SALT Art & Music (salted.no), a practice akin to visiting a brewery in America. Like every moment we've spent in Norway, it's magical, unique and a memory to write home about.


